We will also stop doing the online sign-up for worship.

A sign from the diocese is to be placed on church buildings stating that both masked and unmasked worshippers are welcome.

The vestry decided to send a thank you card to Kelly Kennedy for helping Chuck and Joanne Messley remove the stumps next to the church.

The carpenter is supposed to start on the porch at the RB house in the next couple of weeks.

We still need to find someone to maintain the cutting garden.

It was suggested that we use the calendar on our webpage for various groups to sign up to use the fellowship hall to prevent future conflicts of time.

We still need to have someone to contact for the Boy Scouts who use the fellowship hall.

Deb Hanson reminded the Vestry that we need to count all of the money for both services after the 11:00 service.

Deb Hanson can't figure out why some newsletter emails bounce that have hotmail and outlook addresses.

Deb Hanson thinks that we have around \$2000 left in the food pantry budget. Selena Ellis suggested putting plastic cutlery, can openers and dental care products in the pantry. Rev. Bruno suggested putting a list of items needed in the pantry in the newsletter again.
